BEFORE Parade

- 20 - 24 Staging Divisions. 4 per Division.**
- 4 Runners for assisting the Check-in booth.**
- 2 - 4 Assistants at the Parade Breakfast.**
- 2 - 4 To assist with the Band competition, and then...
(will be reassigned when the Band Competition is completed).**
- 2 - 4 To assist with the JROTC competition, and then...
(will be reassigned when the JROTC Competition is completed).**

DURING Parade

- 30 - 40 Carrying Parade banners (could be youths).**
- 2 - 4 Assistants for the Staging Coordinator.**
- 2 Assistants for the Parade Coordinator.**
- 2 Assistants at the Parade Reviewing Stand.**
- 1 Individual with a pick-up truck at the end of Parade route
to collect banners and Parade equipment.**
- 2 Individuals to pass out Parade Participation Certificate Plaques
at the end of the Parade route.**
- 10 Individuals to assist with the Parade Program distribution.**

AFTER Parade

- 4 - 6 Individuals to pick up trash along Parade route and stage
for pick up by pick-up trucks.**
- 4 Individuals with 2 pick-ups to collect trash and recycle boxes
after Parade.**
- 4 - 6 Individuals to police the North Parking Lot staging area.**
